International Airport

The **Philip Goldson International Airport** is the only international airport in Belize. It features a runway length of over 9,500 feet with aviation signs and lights. It also utilizes modern equipment and gear for fire safety services, and has new radar technologies additional for safety and security. Safety features such as new fire trucks.

Domestic Flights

Airstrips are located country-wide from North to South. They utilize smaller crafts than commercial airline carriers, and are used primarily for transportation of persons, luggage, and mail. These flights run within mainland towns and also include some islands on their flight itinerary.

Highways

Highways and major roads are paved for all-weather usage, making ideal surfaces for transportation or shipping of goods from factory to port. Roadways in expanding communities and towns are consistently being paved or upgraded in order to enhance and maximize the efficient use and accessibility of the country in general.
